

APEAS-II Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What is APEAS?

Adapted Physical Education Assessment Scale-II (APEAS II) is a longitudinal data system easily used by teachers to reach objective, data-driven decisions that help provide information for IEP goal development and student Present Level of Performance.

APEAS II measures four areas of motor performance for students, from 4.5 to 17 years, as well as adaptive behaviors that limit a student's ability to participate in general physical education.

APEAS II measures:

- Perceptual Motor Function
- Object Control
- Locomotor Skills
- Physical Fitness
- Adaptive Behaviors

Use APEAS II to monitor students' progress and make instructional decisions from early childhood to graduation as well as put data into action in the form of reports.

APEAS-II supports a variety of different web browsers including Internet Explorer 7+, Safari, Mozilla Firefox and more. In addition, APEAS-II is set-up for mobile web access.

Is the test valid and reliable?

Currently no, the test is undergoing a validity and reliability study currently with results expected in the Summer of 2018.

Why/How should I use the test if it is not valid and reliable?

The APEAS-II provides a nice structure that is aligned with the general PE curriculum and allows teachers to obtain baseline data for student performance, which is what is needed for IEP goal development. What it does not provide is a developmental comparison to same-age, typically developing peers (because the scores are not validated yet).
